


What you will do – along with your co-worker:




• Co-ordinate the project



 Organise and set up a Steering Group for the project.




 Together with your co-worker you will design a training course for people with learning disabilities at CHANGE. This training will be about hate crime.

 You will aim to provide training and support to Third Party Reporting Centres in Leeds. A Third Party Reporting Centre is a place that someone can go to report a hate crime.




 You and your co-worker will work with the Illustrator to produce an accessible training pack and to make accessible handouts that can be used in the training.

 Make sure that you meet project deadlines.




Go to training to learn about the rights of people with learning disabilities.

Go to training on anything else that CHANGE thinks you need to do your job.




Meet with the Training Manager and your co-worker to discuss your work every 4 weeks.




Go to CHANGE team meetings once a month.

Experience of delivering training.




Will stick up for the rights of adults with learning disabilities, including adults with learning disabilities who are deaf, blind or do not see very well.
